



Titel of lecture: Interprofessionalism in Action – Online Learning International

Description:	Are you interested in working across professional boundaries and learning how to make better decisions together with European citizens in need of health and social care design? This course offers a unique interprofessional learning experience for bachelor students from health and social care sciences or master students from these or technology sciences who aim to strengthen collaboration, communication, and person-centered practice skills. In small, interprofessional groups, you will learn with, from and about a service user and the roles and perspectives of other professions, and practice shared decision-making in a structured and supportive learning environment. You will develop treatment and support plans collaboratively, always keeping the person and the healthcare needs at the center. Timely registration by end of October is needed. For registered students, attendance at all sessions of the intensive lectures within the international week as well as preparatory and follow-up assignments will be mandatory. The course can be extended with self-paced learning modules with 1 or 3 more ECTS.
Assessment:	Guided application of a user-centered design assignment (persona, scenario, use case) and methodological reasoning / reflective justification of the contributions.
